AROMATICS

There are aromas of saltwater salinity, clean linens, daffodil flowers, and wet stone lift from the glass. Oak aging has provided rich crème brûlée, brown spice, and toasty notes.

PALATE

RICH TEXTURED ENTRY WITH STONE FRUIT, GOLDEN APPLE PIE-A-LA MODE, BANANA CUSTARD, AND KEFIR LIME ZEST MELD TOGETHER FOR A DELICIOUS OUTCOME. ELEGANT AND BALANCED WITH BLANCHED MARCONA ALMONDS, LAVASH BREAD, AND A HINT OF SALINITY WITH A LONG BRIGHT FINISH.
